Ian and Tiffanie Rowley, along with their two daughters, Emilyn and Sophia, have served as PAONL global workers in Phnom Penh, Cambodia since 2012. Ian oversees the Global Student Center and dorm that aims to reach university students. They engage students through their Language/Music school, along with a host of other activities that are offered at the center. With full housing for 100 students in the dorm and through genuine relationship with the university students off site, many of them have come to faith and are now connected in the discipleship and Bible study classes offered, and to Global's growing church. Many of these original students from 2014 are now the pastors and leaders for the ministry. The Rowleys have purchased land and are looking forward to building a center that will be their very own and house 200 university students in the dorm.

Tiffanie administers the ChildCARE Plus program in Cambodia. There are currently 12 community-based sites and 13 staff members that help to oversee 600+ children in the program. The program helps the child receive education, feed their families, look after their medical needs and sees them through to post secondary studies...breaking the cycle of poverty. While the physical needs are met, lives are also transformed by the gospel through intentional relationship with the staff and local bodies of believers! Children who started back in 2012 have now graduated grade 12, attended post secondary studies and have good jobs...all while living life for Christ. What a testimony!
